 - Indoor Project auction didn't have the 4% come out of checks in 2020 and that was rectified in 2021.
 - Scale fee is coming out of Livestock

 - May want to explore premiums on outdoor to transfer those to Livestock. The other side is that those are covered by entry fees.
 - Discussion on Enrollment fees.
