Contest Rules:

The contest is open to <u>all</u> residents in the Lewis & Clark County Farm Bureau Area; including areas of Avon, Helmville, and Boulder .

- No entry fee. (Entry form must be submitted by below deadline to be judged)
- Participants can be individual or team of participants.
- Participants must arrange their own venues to display their sculptures (including obtaining permission from the land owner).
- All hay sculptures must be in place and ready for judging by early morning on October 22nd.
- Should be displayed along High Traffic areas for visibility.
- Large or small!! No size requirements and the hay sculptures must be made of at least 85% hay or straw.

Bale Sculptures will be judged on:

- 1. Originality and creativity ... 80%
- 2. Promotion of Lewis & Clark County Farm Bureau and agriculture ...20%

Prizes will be CASH (\$500, \$300, \$100) to the top three Sculptures!! There will also be a People's Choice Category this year worth \$100.00!!
