Simple Tote Bag

How to Make a Reversible Tote Bag



For a finished tote bag size 10" x 13" you will need:

- 2 pieces of fabric 14" (width) x 16" (length) for the outside of the tote bag * (1/2 yard fabric)
- 2 pieces of fabric 14" (width) x 16" (length) for the inside of the tote bag * (1/2 yard fabric)
- 2 pieces 4" x 30" for the straps
- *If you have a different size in mind, add 4" to the width and 3" to the length of the desired finished size.

The Straps

- 1. Press the 4" x 30" fabric pieces in half lengthwise right sides together.
- 2. Stitch a $\frac{1}{2}$ " seam along the raw edges (not the fold). Do not stitch the ends.
- 3. Turn right side out; press seam in the center of the strap or if making a reversible bag press the seam to the side.

The Bag



- 1. With right sides together sew ½" seams of the outside fabric and the inside fabric on three sides. (pic #2)
- 2. Pinch bottom corner together, match the seams and stitch across 1 ½" from corner. (pic #3) Do all 4 corners. (pic #4)





3. Turn the inside bag right side out. Place inside bag in the outside bag right sides together. (pic #5)



4.) Place straps in between right sides of fabric on each side 3" from the side edges. Match the raw edges, keeping the length of the straps inside. (pic #6)



5.) Pin straps and top edge of bag. Stitch around top of bag ½" from edge. Leave one 3" opening between one set of straps for turning the bag right side out. (pic #7)





- 6.) Turn bag right side out through the 3" opening. (pic #8)
- 7.) Push lining inside the bag and top stitch all the way around the top of bag. This will close up the opening used for turning.
- 8.) Optional: Cut a piece of cardboard the size of the bottom of the bag, cover with fabric and use glue to hold fabric to the cardboard. Push firmly to bottom of bag.
- 9.) Now add your own touches such as outside pockets, inside pockets, closures, trims and other embellishments.
