

## **Supplies**

- 2 rectangle pieces of fabric sizes 19" wide x 26" long
- \* 1 rectangle of cotton batting 18 ½" wide x 25 ½" long (just slightly smaller then the fabric rectangles)
- Scissors, thread, straight pins, ruler, marking pencil
- Step 1 Place fabric rectangle pieces right sides together.



- Step 2 Pin batting to wrong side of rectangles ¼" from the edges
- Step 3 On the top of the rectangle (18" end) mark 7" from each side the opening.
- Step 4 Starting on the marking on the right side of the opening, stitch all 4 sides with a ½" seam allowance. Stitch off the fabric at the corners do not pivot. Backstitch at the start and stop of the opening.
- Step 6 Cut all 4 corners at an angle ¼" above the stitching



- Step 7 Turn right side out. Gently push the corners out to a point. Press.
- Step 8 Fold under the seam at the opening at the top; pin and press.
- Step 9 Topstitch all sides of the rectangle pivoting at the corners.

  Use a longer stitch length.
- Step 10 Fold the bottom (18" end) up 5". Pin the sides.
- Step 11 Sew the side seams along the topstitching.
