



Supplies

- 2 rectangle pieces of fabric sizes 19" wide x 26" long
- 1 rectangle of cotton batting 18 ½" wide x 25 ½" long (just slightly smaller than the fabric rectangles)
- Scissors, thread, straight pins, ruler, marking pencil

Step 1 Place fabric rectangle pieces right sides together.



Step 2 Pin batting to wrong side of rectangles ¼" from the edges

Step 3 On the top of the rectangle (18" end) mark 7" from each side the opening.

Step 4 Starting on the marking on the right side of the opening, stitch all 4 sides with a ½" seam allowance. Stitch off the fabric at the corners - do not pivot. Backstitch at the start and stop of the opening.

Step 6 Cut all 4 corners at an angle ¼" above the stitching



Step 7 Turn right side out. Gently push the corners out to a point. Press.

Step 8 Fold under the seam at the opening at the top; pin and press.

Step 9 Topstitch all sides of the rectangle pivoting at the corners. Use a longer stitch length.

Step 10 Fold the bottom (18" end) up 5". Pin the sides.

Step 11 Sew the side seams along the topstitching.

Step 12 With the caddy right side up, mark 3" from the left side, 6" from the left side, 8" from the left side. Draw the sewing lines.

Step 13 Sew along the marked sewing lines to create pockets. Backstitch at the start and stopping.
