Making Your Own Pillowcase

A standard size pillow case measures 20 by 28 inches

What you'll need:

- * 1 yard of fabric (42" to 45" wide)
- * Sewing machine
- * Matching thread
- * Measuring tape or ruler
- * Shears
- * Straight pins
- * Iron

How to make a one piece pillowcase:

- 1. Fold body fabric right side together. Pin pattern to fabric or measure rectangle 34" x 21". Cut along solid line.
- 2. Pin sides and bottom end. Sew using a 1/2" seam allowance. Be sure to backstitch all beginning and ending seams.
- 3. Fold over the open end 1/2" from the top. Press this edge.
- 4. Fold over 4" from the top. Sew along this first folded edge.
- 5. Turn pillowcase right side out. Push out the corners. Press

How to make a pillowcase with contrasting band:

- 1. Fold body fabric right side together. Pin pattern to fabric or measure rectangle 30" x 21". Cut along solid line.
- 2. Fold contrast fabric in half, cut band 9" by 21".
- 3. Sew band on top end of body using 1/2" seam allowance. Press seam towards top
- 4. Pin sides and bottom end. Sew using a 1/2" seam allowance. Be sure to backstitch all beginning and ending seams.
- 5. Fold over the open end 1/2" from the top. Press this edge.
- 6. Fold over 4" from the top folded edge. Cover the seam and sew ¼" along this folded edge.
- 7. Turn pillowcase right side out. Push out the corners. Press.
